

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The Lincoln County Planning and Zoning Committee will hold a Public Hearing on Thursday, March 11, 2010 at 10:00 a.m. to take testimony on the items listed below. The Committee will also tour the site on Thursday, March 11, 2010. The tour will depart at 8:30 a.m. from Lincoln County Service Center, Meeting room #156, at 801 N. Sales St., Merrill, WI.

CONDITIONAL USE REQUEST

1. A request by Jeremy and Julie Belant to allow for a classic automobile restoration shop as an expanded home occupation in a Rural Lands 4 zoning district. The property is located in the W $\frac{1}{2}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 30, T32N–R8E, in the Town of Schley, and has an address of N2916 County Road G. The request is being heard under section 17.3.09(8) of Lincoln County Ordinances.
2. A request by Randall Ryan to allow for a trailer repair and tack shop as an expanded home occupation in a Rural Lands 4 zoning district. The property is located in part of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 19, T33N–R8E, in the Town of Russell, and has an address of N5756 County Road J. The request is being heard under section 17.3.09(8) of Lincoln County Ordinances.
3. A request by the Town of Merrill to allow for the construction of a town hall and garage in a Planned Industrial zoning district. The property is located in part of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 30, T32N–R7E, in the Town of Merrill. The request is being heard under section 17.3.05(5) of Lincoln County Ordinances.

NOTE: A final decision on any of the above requests may be made at a later date. Items not acted upon or laid over will come before the Committee again as “Old Business.” The Committee is not obligated to take any additional testimony, but if new information is available on an old business item, the Committee may accept additional testimony.
