

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

**COMPREHENSIVE PLAN AMENDMENT**

1. A request by James Swan to amend the Lincoln County Comprehensive Plan Map from Rural Lands to Crossroads Mixed Use for tax parcel 04.063406.011.001.01.02, comprising approximately 14 acres, to allow for the potential to build mini-storage facilities. The property is located in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 06, T34N-R6E, in the Town of Bradley, with a parcel address of W7248 State Rd 86.

**PETITION FOR REZONING**

2. A request by James Swan to rezone approximately 14 acres having a tax parcel 04.063406.011.001.01.02, from a Rural Lands 2 zoning district to a Crossroads Mixed Use zoning district to allow for the potential to build mini-storage facilities. The property is located in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 06, T34N-R6E, in the Town of Bradley, with a parcel address of W7248 State Rd 86.

NOTE: A final decision on any of the above requests may be made at a later date. Items not acted upon or laid over will come before the Committee again as "Old Business." The Committee is not obligated to take any additional testimony, but if new information is available on an old business item, the Committee may accept additional testimony.
