Notice to Dog Owners

Obtain a License from the Local or County Treasurer or the Humane Society:

Pursuant to Chap. 174, Wis. Stats., Ch. 12, Lincoln Co. Code, every owner of a dog more than 5 months of age on January 1 of any year, or 5 months of age within the license year, shall annually on or before the date the dog becomes 5 months of age, pay his dog license tax and obtain a license therefore. No such license shall be applied for without compliance with the rabies control section of the County Code

Penalty:

Lincoln County Code, Ch. 12.01 (1) (c) Penalty for Unlicensed Dog = \$100

Dogs Must Be Vaccinated Against Rabies:

The vaccination must be administered by a veterinarian. It must be done within 30 days after the dog reaches the age of 4 months and revaccinated within one year after initial vaccination. After that, the dog must be revaccinated within 3 years.

Other Ordinance Penalties:

Other ordinance penalties exist for dognapping, failure to have dog vaccinated, abandonment, dogs running at large, and failure to provide proper food and shelter: first offense \$5.00 to \$500.00, plus court costs.
