Department Mission: *The mission of the Veterans Service Office is to inform, advice, and assist veterans, their spouses and dependents in securing entitlements and other benefits from the Federal Department of Veterans Affairs and the Wisconsin Department of Veterans Affairs.*

The Lincoln County Veterans Service Office provided information and assistance to veterans and their families in applying for benefits from the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA), State of Wisconsin (WDVA), and Lincoln County. The information for 2007 is listed in each of these areas.

DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS (VA): VA Benefits total \$8,190,770.00

1. Compensation for service connected disabilities, pensions for non-service connected disabilities, dental care, education, insurance, housing loans, medical care and burial benefits.

STATE OF WISCONSIN: State of Wisconsin Benefits total \$89,532.00

1. GRANTS: Paid in Calendar Year 2007
 - a. EDUCATION, SUBSISTENCE AID, AND HEALTH CARE AID GRANTS: Made to eligible veterans to assist them in paying for education, temporary living expenses, and health care. \$16,732 was paid for 34 claims.
2. LOANS: Estimates provided by Wisconsin Department of Veterans Affairs.
 - a. PERSONAL LOAN PROGRAM: Maximum loan of \$25,000.00 at 6.25-10% interest, for education expenses, debt consolidation, purchase of a business or business property, purchase of a mobile home, or medical and funeral expenses. \$72,800 was loaned to 8 veterans.
 - b. PRIMARY HOUSING LOAN PROGRAM: \$0 was loaned to 0 veterans.
3. WISCONSIN VETERANS HOMES – KING, WI AND UNION GROVE, WI: Provides extensive personal maintenance and medical care for disabled veterans and their spouses. Currently, 14 veterans, wives or widows from Lincoln County reside at King and Union Grove Veteran Homes.
