Cutting Instructions:

Contract available for inspection

1. Clearcut area: cut all living trees greater than 1 inch in diameter except for oak, butternut, spruce, tamarack, pine, cedar, cherry and hemlock. Selection harvest area: cut all ironwood and orange paint marked trees. Snags and dead trees are only to be cut if leaving them standing presents a safety hazard to the harvesting operation.

2. All logging damage/debris must be corrected/removed from trails, woods roads, and grass openings daily and prior to sale closure.

3. Any roadwork will require prior approval of the Forestry Department and will follow BMP guidelines. Contractor is responsible for installing water bars and/or using other soil stabilizing techniques where appropriate.

4. Special care must be taken to not damage or disturb survey markers.

5. Special care must be taken to limit damage to advanced regeneration.

6. In order to protect advanced regeneration, whole tree skidding with tops attached is subject to field approval.

7. Skidding down the Ice Age Trail is prohibited unless unavoidable.

8. Logging activity is prohibited from April 15 to July 15 to reduce the risk of introducing and/or spreading oak wilt.

9. Mixed hardwood pulp weight estimate is approximately 46% white birch. Basswood pulp weight estimate is approximately 3% fir. Mixed hardwood log volume includes approximately 59% basswood, 28% soft maple, 11% ash, and 2% sugar maple.

10. Permission must be granted by the Forestry Department to use the snowmobile trail from December 1 to March 31. Ample snow cover must be maintained to allow safe snowmobile operation.
