


1. Selection harvest area: cut all ironwood, all merchantable aspen, and orange paint marked trees. Snags and dead trees are only to be cut if leaving them standing presents a safety hazard to the harvesting operation.
2. All logging damage/debris must be corrected/removed from trails, woods roads, and grass openings daily and prior to sale closure.
3. Any roadwork will require prior approval of the Forestry Department and will follow BMP guidelines. Contractor is responsible for installing water bars and/or using other soil stabilizing techniques where appropriate.
4. Gates/berms removed or damaged by contractor must be restored to original or better condition when sale becomes inactive and upon completion.
5. Loop Road is closed for winter recreation from December 1 to March 31.
6. Skidding down the Ice Age Trail is prohibited unless unavoidable.
7. This sale is located in a heavily used, highly visible location of the county forest. Horseback, cross-country, snowshoe and bike trails run through portions of this sale. Landings must be kept small and care must be taken to protect the recreational activities occurring in this area. No harvesting activities are allowed when cross-country ski trails are open.
8. Mixed hardwood pulp volume estimate is approximately 78% white birch and contains less than 1% basswood and oak pulp. Mixed hardwood log volume estimate is approximately 90% white birch, 5% soft maple, 3% yellow birch and 2% sugar maple, basswood and red oak.
9. Lincoln County's Annosum Root Rot Policy must be followed during the harvest in the pine thinning.
