

Cutting Instructions:

Contract available for inspection

1. Cut all ironwood, all merchantable fir, and orange paint marked trees. Within the restricted equipment zone (REZ) only cut fir containing 3 or more merchantable pulp sticks and orange paint marked trees. Snags and dead trees are only to be cut if leaving them standing presents a safety hazard to the harvesting operation.
2. All logging damage/debris must be corrected/removed from trails, woods roads, and grass openings daily and prior to sale closure.
3. Any roadwork will require prior approval of the Forestry Department and will follow BMP guidelines. Contractor is responsible for installing water bars and/or using other soil stabilizing techniques where appropriate.
4. Gates/berms removed or damaged by contractor must be restored to original or better condition when sale becomes inactive and upon completion.
5. Wheeled or tracked equipment is prohibited in the restricted equipment zone (REZ) unless agreed upon in writing. Biomass harvesting is prohibited within the REZ.
6. Contractor is responsible for obtaining permission to cross private property.
7. Special care must be taken to not damage or disturb survey markers.
8. Mixed hardwood pulp weight estimate is approximately 20% white birch pulp and less than 1% aspen pulp. Mixed hardwood log estimate is approximately 25% white birch, 11% sugar maple, 4% red maple, 30% white ash, 21% basswood, and 8% red oak.
