**Cutting Instructions:**

Contract available for inspection.

1. Northern-most selection harvest area: cut all ironwood, all merchantable white birch, and orange paint marked trees. Selection harvest area adjacent to Bear Lake: cut all ironwood, and orange paint marked trees. Clear cut areas: cut all living trees greater than 1 inch in diameter except for oak, butternut, black ash, spruce, tamarack, pine, cedar, cherry, non-merchantable fir and hemlock. Do not residual cut non-merchantable trees in low wet areas and drainages. Snags and dead trees are only to be cut if leaving them standing presents a safety hazard to the harvesting operation.
2. Any roadwork will require prior approval of the Forestry Department and will follow BMP guidelines. Contractor is responsible for installing water bars and/or using other soil stabilizing techniques where appropriate.
3. All logging damage/debris must be corrected/removed from trails, woods roads, and grass openings daily and prior to sale closure.
4. Gates/berms removed or damaged by contractor must be restored to original or better condition when sale becomes inactive and upon completion.
5. Wheeled or tracked equipment is prohibited in the restricted equipment zone (REZ) unless agreed upon in writing. Biomass harvesting is prohibited within the REZ.
6. Permission must be granted by the Forestry Department to use the snowmobile trail from December 1 to March 31. Ample snow cover must be maintained to allow safe snowmobile operation.
7. In order to protect advanced regeneration, whole tree skidding with tops attached is subject to field approval.
8. Special care must be taken to avoid damage to residual advanced regeneration.
9. Mixed hardwood pulp weight estimate is approximately 28% white birch pulp and 2% red oak pulp. Mixed hardwood log estimate is approximately 27% red maple, 70% white birch, 2% white ash, and less than 1% yellow birch. Sugar maple log estimate is approximately 24% red oak.
