**Cutting Instructions:****Contract available for inspection**

1. Clear cut area: cut all living trees greater than 1 inch in diameter except for oak, black ash, spruce, tamarack, pine, cedar, cherry, non-merchantable balsam fir and hemlock. Do not residual cut non-merchantable trees in low wet areas and drainages.

Selection harvest area: cut all ironwood, all merchantable aspen, all balsam fir and orange paint marked trees. Snags and dead trees are only to be cut if leaving them standing presents a safety hazard to the harvesting operation.

2. All logging damage/debris must be corrected/removed from trails, woods roads, and grass openings daily and prior to sale closure.

3. Any roadwork will require prior approval of the Forestry Department and will follow BMP guidelines. Contractor is responsible for installing water bars and/or using other soil stabilizing techniques where appropriate.

4. Permission must be granted by the Forestry Department to use the snowmobile trail from December 1 to March 31. Ample snow cover must be maintained to allow safe snowmobile operation.

5. Mixed hardwood pulp weight estimate is approximately 29% white birch. Fir pulp weight estimate is approximately 6% hemlock. Mixed hardwood log volume estimate is approximately 89% white birch and 10% red maple.
