These oak office desks date from 1875-1890's. Decorative gallery on three sides, Eastlake brass pulls on drawer, beading on side of figured side panels. Dimensions are 3' W, 30" H, 27" D.

This particular desk has one broken leg, but all the pieces are there.

This desk has broken front legs, but all the pieces are there.




Oak Closed Door Bookcase-17 \$1,050.00

Late 19th or Early 20th Century. A step down molded cornice with paneled sides. On the left side panel is a dripping of white paint. The midsection has two oak framed glass doors on brass hinges scarred by the removal of a lock. The paneled back appears to have three warped boards and loss of veneer and varnish where a shelf probably was. The oak seven shelving board rest on metal supports and one board may be missing. The base is solid and without blemish. The dimensions of this piece are H 83 ½ " x W 51 9/16" x D 12 1/8". This piece is considered in good condition.



Oak Open Bookcase with Divider-16 \$1,550.00

This piece is from the Late 19th or Early 20th Century. The imposing ornate step down cornice has an egg and dart motif. There is some loss of veneer to the top left section and front of the cornice. Varied size bead boards form the back of the case. Each side of oak divider measures twenty-nine inches. The fourteen shelving boards rest on metal inserts. The bookcase is H 99" 5/16" x W 64" x D 13 1/2". This piece is considered to be in very good condition.



Oak Office Chairs

These were perhaps used for formal meetings. Curved top rail with applied veneer, eleven spindle splat, curved saddle style seat, curved arms, bentwood and straight stretchers with cabriole legs. These range in the condition from very good to excellent.

This particular chair has a cracked seat and is missing one spindle.

Quarter Sawn Oak Closet & Storage Unit-35 \$1,200 SOLD

1900-1910. The step down molding of the cornice has an egg and dart motif surrounding the front and sides of the closet. There is one area of wood loss to the cornice and some loss of varnish on each side of the case. In the midsection two doors on brass hinges that have areas for locks; one still has the brass surrounds. Locks are missing. Inside is a long wooden thick dowel for hanging of garments with shelves above for hat storage. The wooden back of this case piece is missing; a thick paper cardboard material encloses the back. It could easily be replaced. This piece measures H: 72" x W: 98 3/4" x D: 23 1/4". This piece is considered in good condition.





Oak and Leather Judge's Chair with Arm Rests -36 \$650.00

1900-1910. The front and back of the chair have signs of wear. The hand rests have some loss to varnish. The leather on seat has blemishes; however, it is without cuts. The chair has an iron mechanical system to adjust location of seat in the pedestal area. Rubber wheels replace the originals. This chair has dimensions of H: 35 5/8" x W: 24 3/4 " x D: 27". This item is considered in good condition.





Oak Legal Bookcase with Glass Doors-37 \$1,000.00 **SOLD**

Early 20th Century. There are five stacking sections with brass knobs to pull down doors. Four are shown; the fifth section exits without glass. The cornice is curved and molded and can be removed to add or rearrange sections. Each section measures H: 14 ¾" x W: 34"x d: 9 ½". The base is molded and curved as well. There is no loss to wood or finish. The dimensions of the this unit are H: 62 ½"x W: 34" x D: 11". This piece is considered to be in very good condition.



Oak Easel Tripod with Chalk Board and Ledge 38- \$350.00

This piece is from the Early 20th Century. This harkens to the past and those days of shorthand by the court reporters. Lawyers still use this board to draw diagrams essential to trials. All parts function well. The dimensions of this piece are H: 70 1/4" x W: 27 3/4" x D" 30 1/4". This piece is in very good condition.



Birch or Elm Two(2) Shelf Portable Bookcase-39 \$375.00 **SOLD**

20th Century hand made in the Arts 'n Crafts style with cut out handles and feet all balanced and to scale. This bookcase is sturdy and most suitable for office or home use. The measurements of this piece is H: 32"x W:42" x D: 7 3/4". This bookcase is considered to be in very good condition.



Quarter Sawn Oak Book or Display Case-40 \$5,900.00

This large book case is from the 1900-1910, with molded cornice that ends with an egg and dart surround has fifteen shelves and a back of pine vertical boards. The base is also molded. There is minimal loss to wood on the lower side and base. The paper sign on the top right side served as a guide and is attached with tiny black tacks. The dimensions of this piece are H:7'x W:10'5"x D:14". This piece is in very good condition.



Quarter Sawn Oak Book or Display Case-41 \$2,000.00 **SOLD**

This is the exact same design as the above book case. This item is also from the 1900-1910 century. Due to removal of wood from cornice and base on the top right side, its aesthetics has been compromised. Its function, nevertheless, as a book or display case still remains unchanged. The dimensions of the item are H: 7' x W: 10'1"x D: 14". This product is considered to be in good condition.





Quarter Sawn Oak and Pine Book or Display Case-42 \$6,500.00

This piece is from 1900-1910 period. This very large case has a cornice with step down molding and terminates with a small egg and dart motif surround. There are fifteen shelves. Some of the brass/metal shelf rests are missing. The back has vertical pine boards. Small varnish loss on top right below cornice. The base also has step down molding. The dimensions of this piece are H: 7'x W: 13'10"x D: 14 ¾". This piece is considered to be in very good condition.
