The concern is with the posted speed limit on Washington Avenue near the daycare. The request was to have the speed limit possibly reduced to 15mph. Chief Deputy Walrath received a request for additional traffic control at the intersection of STH 17 and CTH G. Specifically a request was made to have a “Yield Sign” installed at southbound STH 17 and CTH G west. The DOT and Lincoln County Highway Department will work together to have a yield sign installed.
