Chief Neff commented that where it is 65 mph drivers aren’t slowing down especially on Hwy 51. Mike Panosh stated Legislation is looking at a new ban on headphones while driving. Fatal crashes are up this year from last, mostly due to the record lows in 2014. He further commented that traffic safety has been great this year. The Chief Deputy commented that he received a citizen call from Gleason requesting Hwy 17’s 35mph zone be extended. No further questions or comments.
