6. Department Written Report: 214 people age 65 and older were hospitalized in Wisconsin due to flu 2012-2013. That is four times higher than 2010, 2011 was 38, 2011-2012 was 19.
7. 2013-2014 DHS and DATCP Permit Fees for Restaurants, Lodging and Recreation, Mobile Home Parks: Fee for packaged food with sales of \$25, 000-1,000,000 was \$292.00. New fees for sales of \$25,000-250,000 - \$250.00; sales of \$250,000 – 600,00 -\$325.00; sales of \$600,000 – 999,999 - \$500.00. Motion made by Caylor and seconded by Loka, all ayes.
8. Bed Bug Policy: Identifying and Preventing Bed Bugs. How to recognize a bed bug, how they grow, reproduce and effects of the bed bugs. Motion made by Dr. Moore and seconded by Loka to approve policy, all ayes.
