1. Call to order: Meeting was called to order by Chairman Loka.

3. Q & A on Written & Financial Reports: Businesses with no license will have to close August 1' 2014. Lincoln County Health Dept. looking to follow County safety policies instead of department policies.
4. STD Prevention Project-Kristi Krombholz,LCHD Public Health Nurse: Text STD health questions to BrdzNBz. Most people with HPV have no symptoms. The STD rate as Dr. Moore puts it, true prevalence a lot higher. Three thousand deaths per year from cervical cancer in USA. The benefit from Cervirix and Gardasil vastly out weigh the risk and side effects.
5. Human Health Hazard Abatement: Shelley shared the third party clean-up process with members. Cleaning up the Health Hazard in Lincoln County no easy task.
6. Strategic Plan: Shelley reviewed the five strategies for the agencies Strategic Plan. This is a five year plan starting in January, 2015. Mandated by the State for programs for the public, with no funding to back programs.
7. Approval of 2015 Immunization Fees: Flu has quad strains-charge will be \$35.00 for public, \$19.00 for county, \$15.00 for Free Clinic. January donation from \$5.00 to \$10.00 per appointment. Motion to approve by Dr. Moore, seconded by Plant. All ayes.
8. Approval of School Nursing Contract: Motion to approve as presented with the change from Corporate Counsel by Plant, seconded by Swanson for both contracts 2014-15 school year Grades 4K through 12 and Merrill Area Head Start Program. Vote 6 ayes, 1 no. Zeitz voting no.
