

**LINCOLN COUNTY LAW ENFORCEMENT COMMITTEE MEETING

1. **CALL TO ORDER:** Meeting was called to order at 7:30 a.m.

2. **Approval of Previous Meeting Minutes:** Mr. Lee asked the minutes to reflect that neither Ms. Bergstrom, nor any officer of any other committee has the right to change/amend the minutes of this committee.
