1. **Meeting was called to order:** 7:30 a.m.
 - A. **Roll call of members present:** All members in attendance.
 - B. **Welcome visitors:** Tom Koth, Diane Hanson, Earl Welker, Mark Handlin, Jeff Kraft.

2. **Reading of last regular meeting minutes:** Motion by Caylor, Second by Krueger to accept and place on file. Carried.

3. **Lutheran Social Services Update:** Earl Welker said the final figures were received for August and September. 5 applications were received. 1 was approved and going out today (transfer from Sheboygan County). 3 more people were added to day reporting. Judges seem to be very satisfied with the day reporting program, communications have opened up. However, Probation and Parole are still not too receptive, but Mr. Welker hopes that they will come around.

4. A. **Sheriff's Report:** Sheriff's statistical report was mailed with committee packets. The Budget recap was distributed at the meeting.

6. **Jail Maintenance Update:** Lt. Kraft said the drain coverings have been replaced. The fan in the Laundry Room has been replaced with a larger capacity fan. Joel Wendt is looking into resolving the issue as well in the inmate storage room.

- A. **Inmate Telephone Contract Renewal:** Contract will expire the end of December. Presently the jail is receiving a 31% commission, which is low compared with some other counties. Some counties are also receiving signing bonuses for 3 or 5 year contract. If there will be a change within the next couple of years in the number of beds, it may be worthwhile looking into another vendor.

Motion by Caylor, Second by Plant to authorize Lt. Kraft to look into a 3-year contract. Carried.
