1. **Call Meeting to Order:** Meeting was called to order at 7:30 a.m.
2. **Approve Minutes of Previous Meeting:** Motion by Krueger, Second by Caylor to approve as printed. All ayes, motion carried.
3. **Lutheran Social Services Update:** No report received.
4. **Coroner's Report:** No report received.
5. **A. Sheriff's Report:** Sheriff said that we are now housing 20 inmates per day from Marathon County, generating \$900 per day in revenues. Motion by Krueger, Second by Caylor to place on file. All ayes, motion carried.  
**B. Recreational Officer's Report:** Motion by Caylor, Second by Krueger to place on file. All ayes, motion carried.  
**C. 9-1-1 Supervisor's Report:** Motion by Lee, Second by Krueger to place on file. All ayes, motion carried.
6. **False 9-1-1 Calls:** Mr. Mittelsteadt advised the Sheriff that while he was away from home, the Sheriff's Department received a couple of 9-1-1 calls from his home. The Sheriff contacted Frontier who informed him that several factors may have been the cause for the false 9-1-1 calls (i.e.; lightning and saturation of the ground).
7. **Jail Maintenance Update:** Dave Manninen said two issues came to light. He said the State adopted a new mandate concerning carbine monoxide detectors. He said that none had been installed during the course of the new construction. He contacted Simplex Grinnell to correct the issue.
