**OPEN MEETING**

1. **Call to Order:** Meeting was called to order at approximately 7:30 a.m.
2. **Approve Minutes of Previous Meeting:** Motion by Krueger, Second by Giese to approve minutes as printed and place on file. Unanimous. Carried.
3. **Lutheran Social Services Update:** Report distributed at the meeting.
4. **Coroner's Report:** Report distributed at meeting and brief update on ATV and fire death in Tomahawk. Motion by Krueger, Second by Lee to place on file. Unanimous. Carried.
5. **A. Sheriff's Reports:** Motion by Giese, Second by Krueger to place on file. Unanimous. Carried.

**Additional informational topics:**

- 1). Sheriff informed the committee that Communications will provide dispatch duties for the Tomahawk Police Department from 11 p.m. to 7 a.m. Monday through Friday and 11 p.m. to 11 a.m. on Saturdays and Sundays beginning on January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2011.
- 2). Sheriff Jaeger also informed the committee that Probation and Parole asked for officer's to accompany their agents on home visits to make arrests when necessary. The Sheriff said he declined because the Sheriff's Office did not have sufficient manpower; it would subsequently increase overtime costs, as well as conflict with their road duties.

- C. 9-1-1 Supervisor's Report:** Written report included in committee packets. Brief verbal report to inform committee that the Sheriff's Department will begin dispatching for Tomahawk. Mr. Handlin is working with IT to allow the Tomahawk Police Department access to the County's network.
- 6. Parking Issues:** Mr. Mittelsteadt asked that this item be placed on the agenda after briefly discussing this issue last month. Mr. Giese said that they are looking into additional parking along with Joel Wendt and are planning to implement angled parking. Mr. Giese said he will provide an update at next meeting.
- 7. Jail Maintenance:** No issues to discuss other than the kitchen venting issue is being looked into.
