OPEN MEETING

- 1. Call to Order:** Meeting was called to order by the Chair at 7:30 a.m.
- 2. Approval of previous meeting minutes:** Motion by Mittelsteadt, Second by Krueger to approve the minutes of the previous meeting with no corrections or additions. Unanimous. Carried.
- 3. LSS Update:** Report was distributed by Tracy Lambrecht at the meeting and was reviewed by the committee. It is to be noted that the savings to Lincoln County was \$3,668.30.
- 4. Coroner's Report:** Mr. Proulx was absent and no report was received.
- 5. Sheriff's Statistical Report:** Mr. Lee questioned 6 adult transports indicating accumulative mileage of 3,070. Monthly reports were reviewed and the figures listed were correct as reported. Motion by Lee, Second by Krueger to place on file. Unanimous. Carried.
 - A. Expense Budget, Revenue Budget, Vendor List:** No comments or questions.
 - B. Recreational Officer Activity Report:** Mr. Lee noted that there was no patrol hours indicated on the Forestry section of the report, when there was activity. Motion by Lee, Second by Caylor to place on file. Unanimous. Carried.

- C. 9-1-1 Supervisor's Report:** Report was included in committee packets and briefly discussed at meeting. Everything seems to be moving along. Narrowbanding to take place in June. Motion by Caylor, Second by Lee to approve report and place on file. Unanimous. Carried.
- 6. Huber Releases:** The informational issue was discussed and no committee action was necessary.
- 7. Replacement of Correctional Officer:** At the time the agenda went out, there was only one replacement needed. However, that has since changed to 2 replacements. Both correctional officers were probationary employees; one went to the Wausau Police Department and the other to Tomahawk. Motion by Caylor, Second by Krueger to approve replacement of 2 probationary Correctional Officers. Unanimous. Carried.
- 8. Replacement of Sergeant Investigator:** This will be re-addressed at a future meeting.
- 9. Jail Maintenance Update:** No issues to address.
- Mr. Caylor asked the minutes to reflect his appreciation to Deputy VanderWyst on his award and to commend all those involved in the severe weather disaster that occurred on April 10th, 2011.
