**OPEN MEETING:**

1. **Call to Order:** Meeting was called to order by the Chair at 7:00 a.m.

  - B. Visitors welcomed.
2. **Approval of previous meeting minutes:** Motion by Caylor, Second by Zeitz to approve minutes of the previous meeting as printed. Unanimous. Carried.
3. **Coroner's Report:** None received this month. Coroner previously advised he would be absent today.
4. **Sheriff's Statistical Report along with Budgets and Vendor List:** Committee had no questions finding all in order.

**B. Recreational Officer Activity Report:** Mr. Zeitz had a question about the Recreational Officer's report showing total hours worked. Sheriff said that besides his regular days off, he uses vacation time. He added that Deputy Watruba is very diligent in working 40 hours a week.

**C. 9-1-1 Supervisor's Report:** Placed on file.

5. **Deputy Replacement:** Vacancy created when a Deputy moved to 9-1-1 Division. Motion by Caylor, Second by Giese to forward to Personnel. Unanimous. Carried.

Firearms Surrender:** Sheriff Jaeger reported that the Lincoln County Courts are participating in a pilot project concerning the surrender of firearms in cases of reported domestic abuse and Temporary Restraining Orders. Sheriff explained his opposition to this project. A meeting has been scheduled for January 16, 2014 at the Service Center to discuss implementation of this pilot program. Motion by Zeitz, Second by Loka to support Sheriff Jaeger in opposition to this matter. Unanimous. Carried.
- 7. Annual Jail Inspection report from Denise Ellis:** Committee had a very favorable opinion of the report, and had no questions, and report was placed on file. They complimented the Jail Administrator and staff for a job well done.
- 8. 2014 Vehicle Replacement:** Sheriff Jaeger said we are looking to replace 3 vehicles for this year, 2 SUV's and 1 sedan. There has been money already budgeted for this purchase.
- 9. Schedule next regular meeting:** Next regular meeting was scheduled for February 12, 2014 at 7:30 a.m. in the Lincoln County Safety Building, Lower Level Conference Room.
- 10. Annual Jail Tour:** Motion by Zeitz, Second by Caylor to convene at 0716 to participate in the annual jail tour. Committee had a very favorable review of the jail and were quite pleased with its appearance. They again thanked all staff for a job well done. No other business was conducted.
