EMERGENCY MEETING
Minutes of April 22, 2014 at 7:30 a.m.
Lincoln County Safety Building, Lower Level Conference Room

1. **Call to Order:** Meeting was called to order at 7:30 a.m.
 - A. Roll call of members present: As noted above.
 - B. Visitors welcomed.

2. **Election of Officers:**
 - A. **Chair:** Mike Loka nominates Bob Lee as Chair. Motion by Loka, Second by Caylor to approve. Unanimous. Motion carried.
 - B. **Vice-Chair:** Bob Lee nominates Dan Caylor as Vice-Chair. Motion by Lee, Second by Loka to approve. Unanimous. Motion carried.
 - C. **Secretary:** Bob Lee nominates Bill Zeitz, Zeitz gives thanks but declines. Dan Caylor nominates Ryan Schwartzman as Secretary. Motion by Caylor, Second by Loka to approve. Unanimous. Motion carried.

3. **Emergency Response Vehicle Procurement:** The U.S. Government is down-sizing the military and is offering these specially made armored vehicles to local law enforcement agencies. The Sheriff explained how this vehicle will be used for rescue of victims, and the protection it offers the officers during dangerous situations. The vehicle will be shipped out of Texas at an estimated cost of \$2800 to \$3600 dollars. We may also need to add one garage door panel.

Motion by Loka, Second by Caylor to approve vehicle purchase. 4 ayes, 1 – nay (Zeitz). Mr. Zeitz opposes it, doesn't believe we need it and will not support it and explained his reasons. Motion carried.

4. **Adjournment:** Motion by Caylor, Second by Loka to adjourn. All ayes, motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 0745.
