1. **Call to Order:** Meeting called to order by Mr. Mike Loka at 7:30a.m.
2. **Coroner's Report:** January Report was reviewed. February Report; no autopsies reported and no accidents. Mr. Proulx reports that the number of autopsies have increased in comparison to last year. He also noted there will be no increase in fees for autopsies by Associates in Pathology. There was some discussion about suicides increasing in the winter, and there was no noticeable change in statistics on this subject.

  - Staffing levels were discussed and how that impacted our 2015 budget.

  - Expense Budget: Budget Expense Report for February will be brought to the next meeting.
