| City of Merrill D3 | *There is one too many votes cast in this district for the following reason: an elector over vote in District 6 and went to the wrong table (District 3) to obtain a new ballot. Elector voted in District 3 with a District 3 ballot causing an excess vote in District 3. |
| City of Merrill D4 | *Missing ballot bag number on GAB104. |

City of Merrill D5 *Type of ballot used should have been optical scan instead of hand count on the GAB104.

City of Merrill D6 *Ballot count doesn't come out because they had trouble with their DS200 machine shutting off by itself.
*An elector over voted and went to the wrong table (District 3) to obtain a new ballot. Elector voted in District 3 with a District 3 ballot causing an under vote in District 6.
*Address changes should be placed on supplement list not just listed on incident log and a new GAB131 should be filled out.

City of Merrill D7 *Used tamper-evident seal number instead of ballot bag number on GAB104.
*Tally sheet missing office name.

City of Merrill D8 *Used tamper-evident seal number instead of ballot bag number on GAB104.

City of Tomahawk W3/4 *Missing ballot bag number on GAB104.

City of Tomahawk W5/6 * Used tamper-evident seal number instead of ballot bag number on GAB104.
