County Clerk Christopher J Marlowe called the Lincoln County Board of Canvass to order at 9:03 a.m. on February 21, 2013, with the following members present: County Clerk Christopher J Marlowe, Marie Steffenhagen, Republican, Joan Schroeder, Democrat.

The Board of Canvass meeting notice was posted per Wisconsin Statutes. The following are the findings upon the review of the reports:

- Town of Birch: Tally Sheet – Statewide officials should not have been checked; judicial box should have been marked.
Entire absentee number should be in red ink.
- Town of Bradley: Certificate of ballots sheet incomplete. Total ballots counted and number of voters not marked.
Inspector Statement – Missing voting unit number and memory device serial number.
- Town of Corning: Absentee ballot log should not be placed in the “Used Absentee Envelope” envelope.
ABS must be on poll book in green ink otherwise no way to determine outstanding absentee voters.
Wrong ABS log – must include voter number.
- Town of Harding: No issues noted.
- Town of Harrison: Inspector Statement – Missing voting unit number.
Voter Statistics – number of ballots cast not indicated in optical scan count.
Absentee ballot should not be opened if returned by USPS belongs in rejected absentee envelope. Not to be counted.
Poll book – no indication of total number of voters, page number of last voter, and number of absentee voters.
ABS should be in green ink.
Absentee number must be in red ink and include “A”
If correction is made to voter information correction should be made in book and name highlighted; not to be added to supplemental list.
Voters voting should not be highlighted for no reason.
Inspector Statement – Absentee vote number 6 – log shows 5
- Town of King: Did not sign zero total report tape.
Inspector Statement – total number of voters should be recorded not total number of registered voters.
Report (precinct) shows 708 registered, report states 710. If registering that day; should show up on supplemental list.
Certificate of Ballots – should indicate new ballot made by inspector.
- Town of Merrill: Poll Book – did not fill out voter counts.
Failed to write ABS in poll books.
All poll book errors should be initialed and listed on inspector’s statement.
- Town of Pine River: No issues noted.

Town of Rock Falls: No issues noted.

Town of Russell: No issues noted.

Town of Schley: No issues noted.

Town of Scott: Optical scan number count not included on inspector statement.

Town of Skanawan: Zero tape not included.
Inspector Statement – did not initial post-election on custody record.
Tally sheet should include write-ins only.

Town of Somo: No issues noted.

Town of Tomahawk: No issues noted.

Town of Wilson: Inspector Statement: missing voting unit number, number of votes recorded as hand count instead of optical scan.
Tally Sheet should include write-ins only.
Poll Book – numbers not included on cover sheet.
Errors in poll book need to be initialed and included in inspector’s statement.

City of Merrill – D1: Inspector’s Statement – custody record chief should initial – not include numbers. Certification should be signed by chief inspector.

City of Merrill – D2: Zero tape not signed.

City of Merrill – D3: Incident Log on Inspector’s Statement – Certificate of ballots when voter remakes ballot should be logged on top line not remade by inspector line.

City of Merrill – D4: No issues noted.

City of Merrill – D5: Optical scan not included on inspector’s statement.

City of Merrill – D6: No zero tape found.
Inspector’s statement – votes recorded under hand count instead of optical scan count.

City of Merrill – D7: Inspector’s Statement – only number rejected ballots if rejected for same voter.

City of Merrill – D8: Certificate of Ballots – damaged ballots recorded on wrong line – remade by voter not inspector.

City of Tomahawk – W 1/2: No issues noted.

City of Tomahawk – W 3/4: No issues noted.

City of Tomahawk – W 5/6: No issues noted.

M/S Steffenhagen/Schroeder to adjourn until 9:00 a.m. on Tuesday, February 26, 2013 for the final canvass after the local MBOC’s have processed late arriving absentee ballots and provisional ballots. Motion carried by unanimous voice vote. Adjourned at 11:36 a.m.
