

Lincoln County Board of Canvass

County Clerk Christopher J Marlowe called the Lincoln County Board of Canvass to order at 9:00 a.m. on November 7, 2014, with the following members present: County Clerk Christopher J Marlowe, Joan Schroeder, Democratic representative and Marie Steffenhagen, Republican representative.

The Board of Canvass meeting notice was posted per Wisconsin Statutes. The following are the findings upon the review of the reports:

- Town of Birch: DS200 Tape - write hand tallied votes and totals on tape.
- Town of Bradley: Supplemental Poll List –pages need to be numbered and voters should be listed in sequential order.
Poll List – last voter listed on wrong page; could not find voter # 144; absentee voters not identified in green ink; three poll workers the whole day? No record found.
- Town of Corning: DS200 Tape - write hand tallied votes and totals on tape.
- Town of Harding: Tally Sheet – Do not tally unregistered write-ins.
Poll List – Absentee voter number should be in red ink.
- Town of Harrison: Auto Mark Ballot – needs to be ran through DS200 machine.
Inspectors Statement – two voters received new ballots (these ballots were labeled as remade – which indicates poll workers remade them & not the voter); indicated that all ballots were hand counted.
Poll List – last voter not circled
Not sure why all votes were hand counted.
- Town of King: Poll List – Last voter not circled
- Town of Merrill: Poll List – Last voter not circled
DS200 Tape – Include hand count ballots and totals on tape.
Certificate of Ballots – Documented new ballots given as remade and not by elector error.
- Town of Pine River: Inspector Statement – No incidents listed even though they ran out of ballots and needed to make more. Not sure if five ballots were remade or reissued.
Inspector Statement was not included with BOC materials – received late.
- Town of Rock Falls: No issues noted.
- Town of Russell: Tally Sheet – No need to tally unregistered write-ins.
Certificate of Ballots – Were ballots remade or elector’s error.
Poll List – Last voter indicated on wrong page.
- Town of Schley: Inspectors Statement – No voter statistics listed.
- Town of Scott: Poll List – Last voter not circled.
- Town of Skanawan: No zero tape
Inspectors Statement – we counted 10 absentee ballots issued not 11.
- Town of Somo: Inspector’s Statement – Total number of voters indicates 90 but only 64 ballots were issued.

Tally Sheet – write ‘none’ if no write-ins were counted.

Town of Tomahawk: Ballots that are over voted need to be remade.

Town of Wilson: Zero tape not signed.
Certificate of Ballots – two remade military ballots not noted.
Absentee Ballot Log – numbers not matching poll list.

City of Merrill – D1: Inspector’s Statement – Post election numbers missing.

City of Merrill – D2: Inspectors Statement – No tamper evident seal number (ballot bag) listed.
Poll List – last voter not circled.

City of Merrill – D3: Certificate of Ballots – did not fill out
Inspectors Statement – Voter Statistics section incomplete for number of votes cast on type (optical scan #)
Poll List – On page 12 voter 263 didn’t sign (not sure if they voted or not)

City of Merrill – D4: Inspector’s Statement – Number needs to be indicated for number of ballots scanned.

City of Merrill – D5: Inspectors Statement – indicates ballots were hand counted.
Poll List – Last voter not circled

City of Merrill – D6: Inspector’s Statement – Number of ballots counted not indicated; indicates ballots were hand counted.
Supplemental Poll List – signatures missing (incident report indicates this)

City of Merrill – D7: Poll List – last voter not circled

City of Merrill – D8: No issued noted.

City of Tomahawk – W 1/2: Tally Sheet – No need to tally unregistered write-ins.

City of Tomahawk – W 3/4: Tally Sheet – No need to tally unregistered write-ins.
Inspectors Statement – Voter statistics section incomplete
Poll List – Last voter not circled

City of Tomahawk – W 5/6: Poll List – Last voter not circled
