

**Lincoln County Board of Canvass**  
**Thursday, April 4, 2013**  
**Lincoln County Service Center, 801 N. Sales St., Merrill WI - Room 258**

County Clerk Christopher J Marlowe called the Lincoln County Board of Canvass to order at 9:00 a.m. on April 4, 2013, with the following members present: County Clerk Christopher J Marlowe, Marie Steffenhagen, Republican, Joan Schroeder, Democrat.

The Board of Canvass meeting notice was posted per Wisconsin Statutes. The following are the findings upon the review of the reports:

- Town of Birch: Voter Registration Application – include voter number
- Town of Bradley: Tally Sheet – Didn't specify which Tomahawk School Board Race for write-in (could not count votes)  
Poll Book – Absentee numbers were missing for numbers 48, 49, and 50
- Town of Corning: Tally Sheet – Didn't include total number for each write-in
- Town of Harding: Tally Sheet – Use numeric numbers for totals
- Town of Harrison: Inspector's Statement – DRE Touch Screen indicated 1 (one) not sure what this meant.  
Clerk didn't seal thumb drive  
Poll List – no indication why Mark Dunst was highlighted; Jeff Renn's address correction should include voter application
- Town of King: Tally Sheet - Didn't specify which Tomahawk School Board Race for write-ins (could not count votes)  
Poll Book – need to make sure you mark ABS in green ink for all voters who requested an absentee ballot.
- Town of Merrill: Zero Tape not signed by poll workers.  
Certificate of Ballots – Absentee ballot was spoiled by voter – not remade.  
Make typo address changes right in poll book not on supplemental list – no need to put on supplemental list.
- Town of Pine River: Tally Sheet - All candidates should be listed in one box using lines within box to list separate candidates - side box should include what office (very time consuming). Do not include offices not on ballot.
- Town of Rock Falls: Last voter on page 2 – not referenced on absentee ballot log.  
Inspector's Statement - Not clear as to what is being described on incident log.
- Town of Russell: Tally Sheet – no hash marks used – how were they tallied.
- Town of Schley: Poll List – ABS voter reference is incorrect. ABS in green ink.
- Town of Scott: No issues noted.
- Town of Skanawan: Suggestions – Highlight poll list changes that need to be made.
- Town of Somo: Certificate of Ballots – no totals listed.

Tally Sheet - Candidates listed on ballot should not be listed again – unless they were true write-ins.

Poll Book – ABS should be listed in green ink.

- Town of Tomahawk: Inspector’s Statement – total number of voters was listed as total number of registered voters. Must indicate total number of voters that voted that day.  
Tabular Statement – List local candidates only.
- Town of Wilson: Tally Sheet should include write-ins only.  
Suggestion – On supplemental poll list, list voter by Last Name then First Name (this makes it easier to find the voter).
- City of Merrill – D1: Certificate of Ballots – be sure to note correctly how ballot was rejected: 1. Elector Error 2. Ballot damaged and remade by inspector  
Tally Sheet – must include tally marks.
- City of Merrill – D2: Certificate of Ballots - Spoiled ballot remade by voter not inspector must be listed properly.  
Inspector Statement – no seal number included.
- City of Merrill – D3: Absentee Ballot Log – missed voter number 70A
- City of Merrill – D4: Tally Sheet – include hash marks. Office was not included – write-ins could not be counted.
- City of Merrill – D5: Inspector’s Statement – indicates that ballots were hand counted and not scanned.
- City of Merrill – D6: Certificate of ballots – incomplete; didn’t include all numbers.  
Tally Sheet – incomplete; write-ins could not be counted. Back of tally sheet not completed.
- City of Merrill – D7: No issues noted.
- City of Merrill – D8: Certificate of Ballots – Incident log indicates a ballot was remade but it was not reflected on this document.
- City of Tomahawk – W 1/2: No issues noted.
- City of Tomahawk – W 3/4: No issues noted.
- City of Tomahawk – W 5/6: No issues noted.

M/S Steffenhagen/Schroeder to adjourn until 9:00 a.m. on Tuesday, February 26, 2013 for the final canvass after the local MBOC’s have processed late arriving absentee ballots and provisional ballots. Motion carried by unanimous voice vote. Adjourned at 2:00 p.m.
