

Land & Water Resource Management Cost Share Program

Land and Water Resource Management Cost-Share program provides technical and financial assistance to landowners to install conservation practices in order to improve soil health, protect and improve water quality, and conserve the natural resources of Lincoln County. Goals to address natural resource concerns and an implementation strategy to achieve those goals are established in the [2017-2026 Land and Water Resource Management \(LWRM\) Plan](#) which is updated every ten years.



Landowners who are interested in obtaining cost-sharing to install a conservation practice on their land should contact the Land Services Department. If a project is eligible, landowners may receive cost-sharing of 50%, 70%, and even up to 90% towards the installation of conservation practices.
