Focus Group/Community Conversations/ Key Informant Interview 2024 d. Legislative Opportunities – Advocacy Days, Legislative Meetings, Website e. Recruitment of Partners	a. Credible Minds – Pending Corporation Counsel and Board of Health Approval. Perhaps will be approved in June. Discussed content of the website. b. Community Resource Hubs Group decided Transportation will be the topic area. Consideration obtaining public and those that serve the public – barrier survey. Host early morning 2-3 hours discussion, Transportation Resource Mapping – agenda topics transportation resources, gaps, future plans. Mondays and Fridays not a good time to have a meeting. Hersil will prep draft agenda and share with members. c. Focus Groups/Community Conversations/Key Informant Interviews – There will be a PRSYL focus group on May 29 <sup>th</sup> . Any questions send to Lexi. ADRC is having one-on-one conversations with the public for their aging plan. d. Legislative Opportunities – Erin gave an overview of ADRC’s approach to legislation networking. Education is the primary role of ADRC and Board/community members are the ones that can make the ask. Starting point for LWL might be to share what we do with our legislatures. Hersil will keep on agenda for future discussion. e. Recruitment of Partners – LCHD is look at completing a QI Project on recruiting involvement with LWL coalitions.
<b>4. Document Results of Strategy Accomplishments</b> a. Partner Round Robin: January – March 2024 b. County Health Rankings	Aspirus Health: Funding both school districts with mental health needs including staff training and Raise Your Voice. Also working on the community paramedic program. There are funds available for projects. Need to assign funds by June 30 <sup>th</sup> . Rumsey is submitting funding request for Learning to Breathe. Obtaining data from the Farmers Market Rx program. Cooking demonstration coming up for PRSYL. Healthfirst: Ribbon cutting for mental health clinic. 2 therapists in place. Participating in Community Baby Shower. Farmers Market vouchers in June. ADRC: Farmers Market vouchers coming up. Will be doing social media public assessment questions as part of the aging plan. Giving out mini-grants for fall prevention. Bingo Size programming for fall and nutrition topics coming up (working with H2N as well). Funding Strong Bones in Merrill. Social Services: Staff have had various training opportunities – Aggression Replacement, Triple P, MSRP.

	<p>Looking at incentives to get people to these programs. Implementing Family First program – assist in providing service for basic needs. Looking at receiving additional funds this year for community intervention programming to go towards youth risk services.</p> <p>LCHD Buntrock: May 30<sup>th</sup> Baby Shower – looking at connecting with H2N and school district to outreach to Hispanic population. Completed Food Pantry Farmers Market assessment with UW Extension. Hygiene drive is one need that came up from assessments.</p> <p>LCHD Bath: Patriated in Raise Your Voice with a booth. Campaigns 988 Veterans, Gun Locks, Mental Health First Aide Training – Merrill and Tomahawk. PRSYL training with Ashley Miller for parents (coping and resiliency) – looking at offering to Tomahawk Headstart and elementary schools. Funding library summer activity programs, 988 campaign focusing on middle age men – in development. Distributed calming strips to elementary schools.</p> <p>Members reviewed county health rankings. A lot of effort but numbers do not seem to get better. Members discussed current affordable and accessible childcare issues in the county. Promoting gleaning opportunities to retail food establishments.</p> <p>Members discussed the need to have better communication of community events to promote social connectedness. How do we get this information out?</p>
