TRAINING DESCRIPTION

Senior and Elected Officials Tabletop Exercise

The Senior and Elected Officials Table Top Exercise (TTX) is for local jurisdiction elected and appointed senior officials. Its purpose is to provide a forum to discuss strategic and executive-level issues related to disaster preparedness, share proven strategies and best practices, and enhance coordination among officials responsible for emergency response to a disaster.

TABLETOP EXERCISE OBJECTIVES

- Discuss roles and responsibilities and preparedness challenges
- Discuss Homeland Security Strategic Planning as it relates to risk and needs assessment and the Emergency Operations Plan for your jurisdiction
- Discuss executive-level incident response and recovery considerations, including medical/public health, situation appraisal, incident management, mutual aid agreements, media relations, recovery and restoration processes, Federal assistance, and business/economic recovery
- Discuss recovery and damage assessment
