- When a county, school district, or special purpose district holds a special election *at a time other than a regularly scheduled election*<sup>\*</sup>, all costs of the election are the responsibility of the jurisdiction calling the special election (all costs of the ballots, supplies, notices and other materials, *including* the cost of the polling place and election inspector(s). Wis. Stats. §§ 5.68(2), (5), 7.03(1)(bm).
  - \* Regularly scheduled elections are the February spring primary and April spring election and, <u>in even-numbered years</u>, the August partisan primary and November general election.
  - +A Special Election is an election scheduled outside the four regularlyscheduled election days.
