Cutting Instructions:

Contract available for inspection

1. Cut all ironwood, all merchantable balsam fir and orange paint marked trees. Snags and dead trees are only to be cut if leaving them standing presents a safety hazard to the harvesting operation.
2. All logging damage/debris must be corrected/removed from trails, woods roads, and grass openings daily and prior to sale closure.
3. Any roadwork will require prior approval of the Lincoln County Forestry Department and will follow BMP guidelines. Contractor is responsible for installing water bars and/or using other soil stabilizing techniques where appropriate.
4. Ingress and egress to this sale is the responsibility of the contractor.
5. Gates/berms removed or damaged by contractor must be restored to original or better condition when sale becomes inactive and upon completion.
6. Wheeled or tracked equipment is prohibited in the restricted equipment zone (REZ) unless agreed upon in writing. Biomass harvesting is prohibited within the REZ.
7. Permission must be granted by the Lincoln County Forestry Department to use the snowmobile trail from December 1 to March 31. Ample snow cover must be maintained to allow safe snowmobile operation.
8. Horn Lake County Forest Road is closed for winter recreation from December 1 to March 31 of each year.
9. Special care must be taken to not damage or disturb survey markers.
10. Special care must be taken to limit damage to advanced regeneration. Direct felling techniques must be used in order to protect advanced regeneration.
11. This sale is located in a heavily used, highly visible location of the county forest. Horseback, cross-country ski, bike and snowmobile trails run through portions of this sale. Landings must be kept small and care must be taken to protect the recreational activities occurring in this area. No harvesting activities are allowed when the cross-country ski trails are open.
12. Mixed hardwood pulp weight estimate is approximately 32% white birch and less than 1% aspen. Mixed hardwood sawlog volume estimate is approximately 61% white ash, 29% white birch, 5% yellow birch, 3% red maple and 1% black ash. Sugar maple sawlog volume estimate is approximately 38% red oak.
