

## **Cutting Instructions:**

Contract Available for Inspection

- 1. Cut all ironwood and orange paint marked trees. Snags and dead trees are only to be cut if leaving them standing presents a safety hazard to the harvesting operation.
- 2. All logging damage/debris must be corrected/removed from trails, woods roads, and grass openings daily and
- 3. Any roadwork will require prior approval of the Forestry Dept. and will follow BMP guidelines. Contractor is responsible for installing water bars and/or using other soil stabilizing techniques where appropriate.
- 4. Ingress and egress to this sale is the responsibility of the contractor.
- 5. Logging activity will be prohibited from April 15 to July 15 of each year to reduce the risk of introducing and/or
- 6. Wheeled or tracked equipment is prohibited in the restricted equipment zone (REZ) unless agreed upon in writing. Biomass harvesting is prohibited within the REZ.
- 7. Permission must be granted by the Forestry Dept. to use the snowmobile trail from December 1 to March 31. Ample snow cover must be maintained to allow safe snowmobile operation.
- 8. Special care must be taken to limit damage to advanced regeneration.
- 9. In order to protect advanced regeneration, whole tree skidding with tops attached will be subject to field
- 10. Unless unavoidable, skidding down the Ice Age Trail is prohibited.
- 11. Due to soil limitations no biomass harvesting is allowed in the SE1/4 SW1/4 S22-T34N-R8E. Tops must be left where they fall or evenly spread throughout the stand following the harvest.
- 12. Gates/berms removed or damaged by contractor must be restored to original or better condition when sale becomes inactive and upon completion.
- 13. Garlic mustard has been found on a woods road within and adjacent to the sale(see map). Soil disturbances on these woods roads must be kept to a minimum in order to help slow the spread of this invasive species. NE1/4 NE1/4 S27-T34N-R8E will be cut last.
- 14. Mixed hardwood pulp weight estimate is approximately 15% white birch and less than 1% aspen. Hemlock pulp weight estimate is approximately 20% balsam fir. Mixed hardwood sawlog volume estimate is approximately 6% red maple, 71% white ash, 2% black cherry, 1% yellow birch and 19% white birch. Red Oak sawlog volume estimate is approximately 4% hard maple. Sweat'n Rock Job
