

Cutting Instructions:

Contract Available for Inspection

1. Clear cut area: cut all living trees greater than 1 inch in diameter except for oak, butternut, black ash, spruce, tamarack, pine, cedar, cherry, hemlock and yellow paint marked trees. Do not residual cut non-merchantable trees in low wet areas and drainages. Selection harvest area: cut all ironwood, all merchantable balsam fir, all merchantable aspen and orange paint marked trees. Snags and dead trees are only to be cut if leaving them standing presents a safety hazard to the harvesting operation.
2. All logging damage/debris must be corrected/removed from trails, woods roads, and grass openings daily and prior to sale closure.
3. Any roadwork will require prior approval of the Forestry Department and will follow BMP guidelines. Contractor is responsible for installing water bars and/or using other soil stabilizing techniques where appropriate.
4. Ingress and egress to this sale is the responsibility of the contractor.
5. Gates/berms removed or damaged by contractor must be restored to original or better condition when sale becomes inactive and upon completion.
6. Logging activity will be prohibited from April 15 to July 15 of each year to reduce the risk of introducing and/or spreading oak wilt.
7. Special care must be taken to not damage or disturb survey markers.
8. In order to protect advanced regeneration, whole tree skidding with tops attached will be subject to field approval.
9. Special care must be taken to limit damage to advanced regeneration.
10. Mixed hardwood pulp weight estimate is approximately 11% white birch. Balsam fir pulp weight estimate is approximately 9% white spruce and 3% hemlock. Mixed hardwood sawlog volume estimate is approximately 50% basswood, 17% white birch, 15% white ash, 12% red maple and less than 1% yellow birch and elm. Red oak sawlog volume estimate is approximately 12% hard maple.
