

Cutting Instructions:

Contract Available for Inspection

- 1) Clear cut area: cut all orange paint marked trees & all living trees greater than 1 inch in diameter except for oak, butternut, spruce, tamarack, pine, cedar, cherry, hemlock, and yellow paint marked trees. Do not residual cut non-merchantable trees in low wet areas and drainages. Pockets of non-merchantable fir that will not impede aspen regeneration may be left uncut with prior approval of the Lincoln County Forestry Department. Selection harvest area: cut all ironwood, all merchantable balsam fir, all orange paint marked trees, all purple paint marked trees delineating canopy gaps, and all trees inside of the delineated canopy gaps. Canopy gaps are delineated by purple paint marked trees located on the gap's perimeter. A purple V faces the inside of the canopy gap. Snags and dead trees are only to be cut if leaving them standing presents a safety hazard to the harvesting operation.
- 2) All logging damage/debris must be corrected/removed from trails, woods roads, and grass openings daily and prior to sale closure.
- 3) Any roadwork will require prior approval of the Lincoln County Forestry Department and will follow BMP guidelines. Contractor is responsible for installing water bars and/or using other soil stabilizing techniques where appropriate.
- 4) Ingress and egress to this sale is the responsibility of the contractor.
- 5) In order to protect advanced regeneration whole tree skidding with tops attached will be will be subject to field approval.
- 6) Unless unavoidable, skidding down The Ice Age Trail is prohibited.
- 7) Special care must be taken to limit damage to advanced regeneration.
- 8) Logging activity will be prohibited from April 15 to July 15 of each year to reduce the risk of introducing and/or spreading oak wilt.
- 9) Mixed hardwood pulp weight estimate is approximately 1% white birch. Mixed hardwood sawlog volume estimate is approximately 41% red maple, 30% white birch, and 28% white ash.
