

Cutting Instructions:**Contract Available for Inspection**

1. Selection harvest area: cut all ironwood and orange paint marked trees. Snags and dead trees are only to be cut if leaving them standing presents a safety hazard to the harvesting operation.
2. All logging damage/debris must be corrected/removed from trails, woods roads, and grass openings daily and prior to sale closure.
3. Any roadwork will require prior approval of the Forestry Department and will follow BMP guidelines. Contractor is responsible for installing water bars and/or using other soil stabilizing techniques where appropriate.
4. Ingress and egress to this sale is the responsibility of the contractor.
5. Gates/berms removed or damaged by contractor must be restored to original or better condition when sale becomes inactive and upon completion.
6. Logging activity will be prohibited from April 15 to July 15 of each year to reduce the risk of introducing and/or spreading oak wilt.
7. Permission must be granted by the Forestry Department to use the snowmobile trail from December 1 to March 31. Ample snow cover must be maintained to allow safe snowmobile operation.
8. In order to protect advanced regeneration, whole tree skidding with tops attached will be subject to field approval.
9. Unless unavoidable, skidding down the Ice Age Trail is prohibited.
10. Special care must be taken to limit damage to advanced regeneration.
11. In order to reduce the risk of spreading Garlic Mustard special care must be taken to limit disturbance to the road system. Garlic Mustard has been found on some of the woods roads leading to and along the sale(see map). Soil disturbances must be kept to a minimum and areas that have Garlic Mustard must be harvested last in order to help slow the spread of invasive species.
12. Mixed hardwood pulp weight estimate is approximately 5% white birch and less than 1% aspen. Balsam fir pulp weight estimate is approximately 30% hemlock. Mixed hardwood sawlog volume estimate is approximately 36% white ash, 37% white birch, 22% red maple, 3% black ash and 1% yellow birch. Red oak sawlog volume estimate is approximately 5% hard maple.
