Cutting Instructions:**Contract Available for Inspection**

- 1) Clear cut area: cut all living trees greater than 1 inch in diameter except for oak, spruce, tamarack, red pine, white pine, cedar, cherry, and hemlock. Pine thinning area: cut all yellow paint marked skid routes and orange paint marked trees. Snags and dead trees are only to be cut if leaving them standing presents a safety hazard to the harvesting operation.
- 2) All logging damage/debris must be corrected/removed from trails, woods roads, and grass openings daily and prior to sale closure.
- 3) Any roadwork will require prior approval of the Lincoln County Forestry Department and will follow BMP guidelines. Contractor is responsible for installing water bars and/or using other soil stabilizing techniques where appropriate.
- 4) Ingress and egress to this sale is the responsibility of the contractor.
- 5) Due to soil limitations, no biomass harvesting is allowed. Tops must be left where they fall, or evenly spread throughout the stand following the harvest.
- 6) This sale is a red pine thinning and Lincoln County's Annosum Root Rot Policy must be followed during the harvest.
- 7) Balsam fir pulp weight estimate is approximately 26% spruce. Jack pine pulp weight estimate is approximately 6% white pine.
