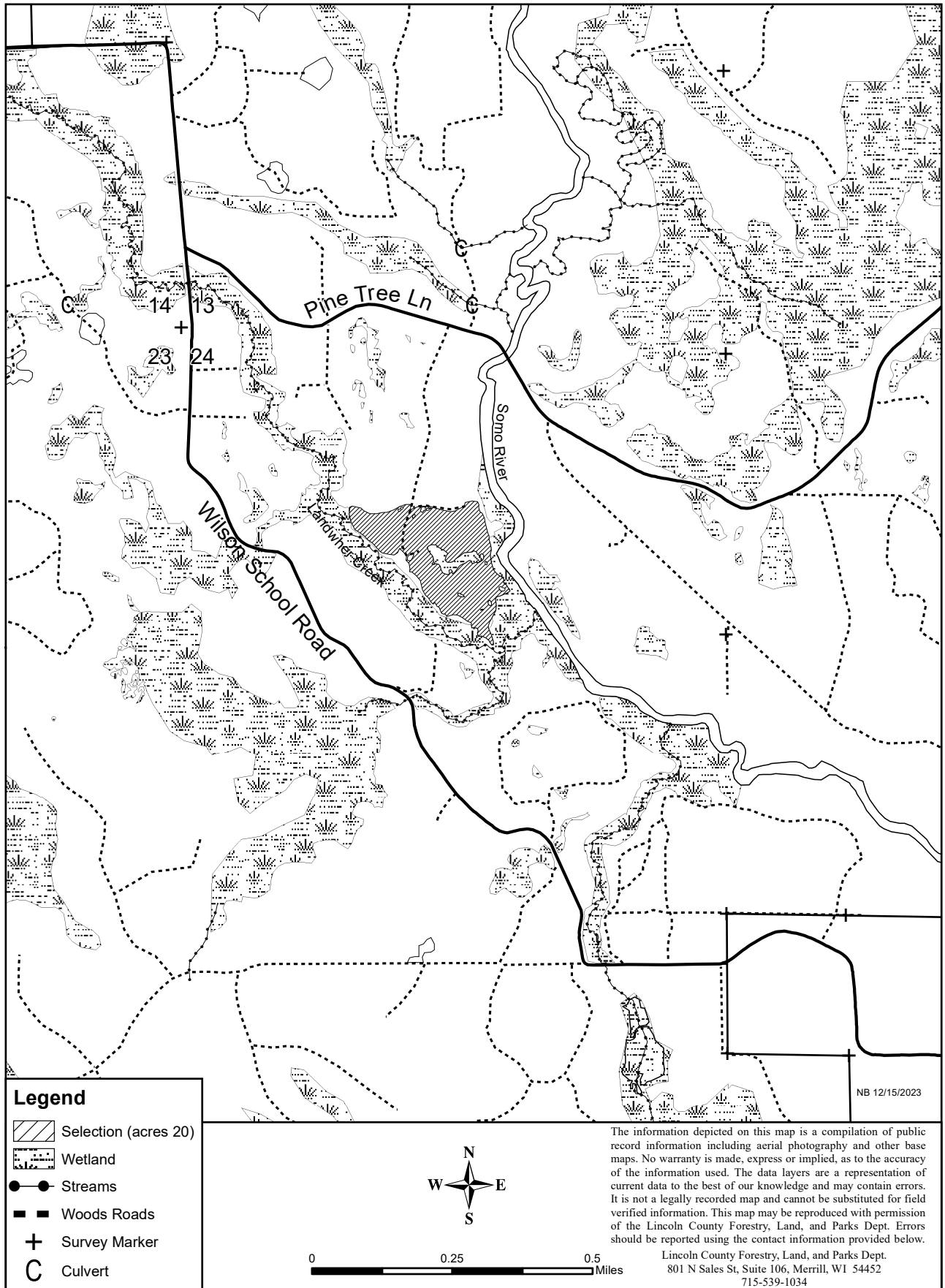



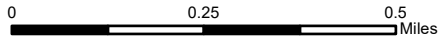
- 1) Selection harvest area: cut all orange paint marked trees and all yellow paint marked skid routes. Snags and dead trees are only to be cut if leaving them standing presents a safety hazard to the harvesting operation. Snags and dead trees cut for safety reasons must be left in the harvest area and may not be utilized.
- 2) All logging damage/debris must be corrected/removed from trails, woods roads, and grass openings daily and prior to sale closure. Slash will be left where it falls unless the contractor wishes to use it to prevent ruts, soil compaction and erosion during logging operations.
- 3) Any roadwork will require prior approval from the Lincoln County Forestry Department and must follow BMP guidelines. Contractor is responsible for installing broad based dips, water bars and/or using other soil stabilizing techniques where appropriate.
- 4) Ingress and egress to this sale is the responsibility of the contractor.
- 5) Due to soil limitations, no biomass harvesting is allowed. Slash will be left where it falls unless the contractor wishes to use it to prevent ruts, soil compaction and erosion during logging operations.
- 6) The entire sale is a red pine thinning and Lincoln County's HRD (Heterobasidion root disease) Policy must be followed during the harvest.
- 7) Special care must be taken to limit damage to the residual trees.
- 8) Red pine pulp weight estimate is approximately: less than 1% jack pine. Aspen pulp weight estimate is approximately: less than 1% mixed hardwoods.
