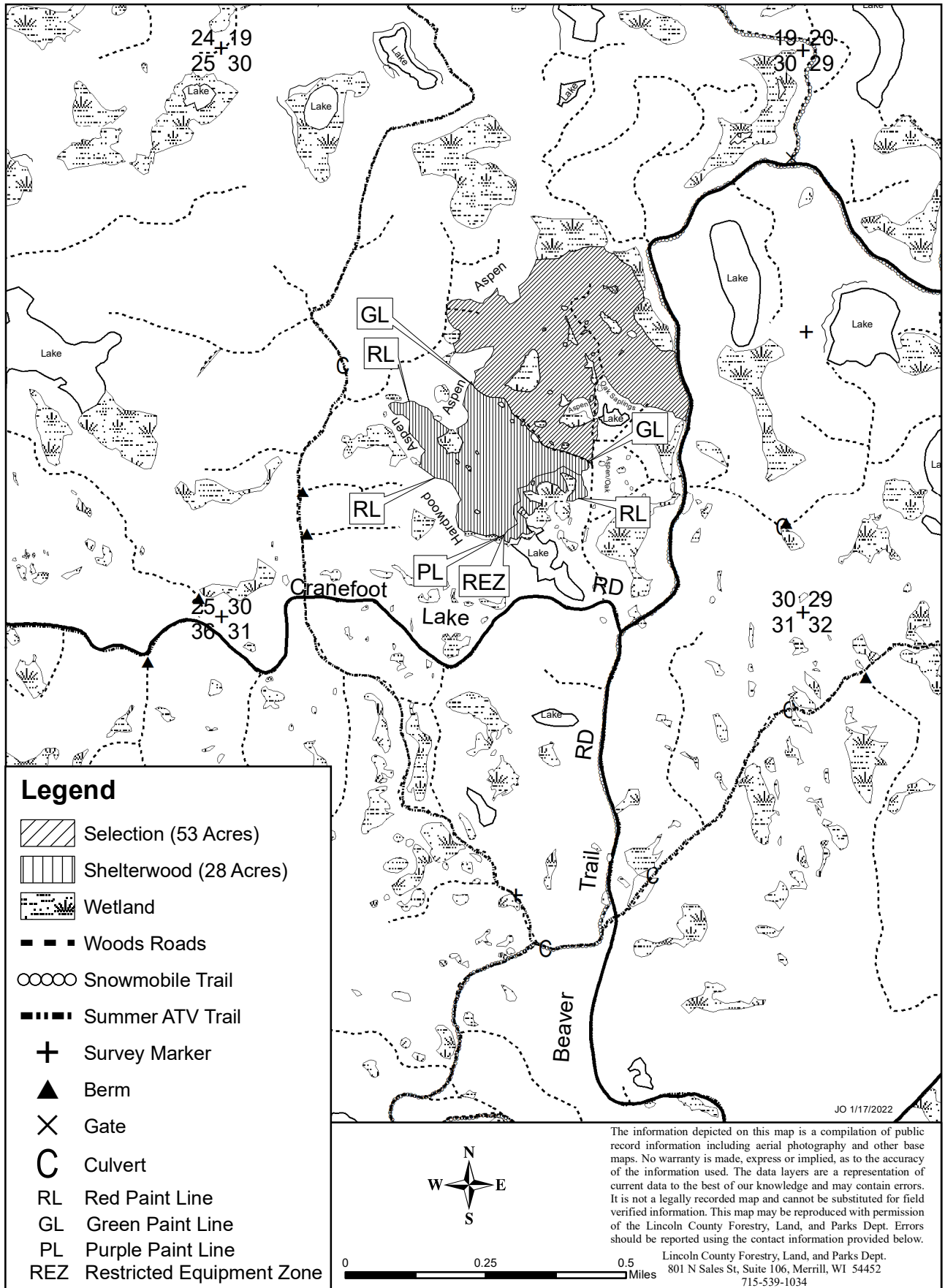



CONTRACT AVAILABLE FOR INSPECTION

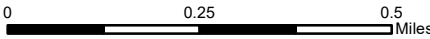
- 1) Selection harvest area: cut all ironwood and orange paint marked trees. Do Not Cut aspen. Avoid damage to residual trees. Shelterwood area: cut all living trees 1 inch and greater except for aspen, spruce, tamarack, pine, cedar, hemlock and yellow paint marked trees. Stump height shall not exceed 6". Do not cut residual non-merchantable trees in low wet areas and drainages. Snags and dead trees are only to be cut if leaving them standing presents a safety hazard to the harvesting operation. Snags and dead trees cut for safety reasons must be left in the harvest area and may not be utilized.
- 2) Logging activity will be prohibited from April 15 to July 15 of each year to reduce the risk of introducing and/or spreading oak wilt.
- 3) Permission must be granted by the Forestry Department to use the snowmobile trail from December 1 to March 31. Ample snow cover must be maintained to allow safe snowmobile operation. (Beaver Trail)
- 4) Selection harvest area is limited to shortwood skidding only.
- 5) Selection harvest area: Special care must be taken to limit damage to advanced regeneration/Special care must be taken to limit damage to saplings. All spring poles (saplings tipped over from harvesting operations) will be cut at the base.
- 6) Wheeled or tracked equipment is prohibited in the restricted equipment zone (REZ), unless agreed upon in writing. Biomass harvesting within the REZ is prohibited.
- 7) Do not operate equipment within 15 feet of the Ordinary High Water Mark (OHWM), ephemeral ponds, and wetlands unless the ground is firm or frozen. Do not operate equipment within 15 feet of lakes.
- 8) All logging damage/debris must be corrected/removed from trails, woods roads, and grass openings daily and prior to sale closure. Slash will be left where it falls unless the contractor wishes to use it to prevent ruts, soil compaction and erosion during logging operations.
- 9) Any roadwork will require prior approval from the Lincoln County Forestry Department and must follow BMP guidelines. Contractor is responsible for installing broad based dips, water bars and/or using other soil stabilizing techniques where appropriate.
- 10) Gates/Berms removed or damaged by the contractor must be restored to original or better condition when the sale becomes inactive and upon sale completion.
- 11) Ingress and egress to this sale is the responsibility of the contractor.
- 12) Mixed hardwood pulp weight estimate is approximately: 1% birch and 1% black ash. Mixed hardwood sawlog volume estimate is approximately: 78% white ash, 20% red maple, and 1% white birch.
