## CONTRACT AVAILABLE FOR INSPECTION

1) In the clear cut area cut all living trees greater than 1 inch in diameter except for oak, white spruce, tamarack, pine, cedar, cherry, hemlock, non merchantable balsam fir, and yellow paint marked trees. Do not residual cut non-merchantable trees in low wet areas and drainages. In the selection harvest area cut all ironwood, all merchantable aspen, all merchantable balsam fir, all merchantable white birch, and orange paint marked trees. Snags and dead trees are only to be cut if leaving them standing presents a safety hazard to the harvesting operation. Non merchantable balsam fir may be cut for operational purposes.

2) All logging damage/debris must be corrected/removed from trails, woods roads, and grass openings daily and prior to sale closure. Slash will be left where it falls unless the contractor wishes to use it to prevent ruts, soil compaction and erosion during logging operations.

3) Any roadwork will require prior approval from the Lincoln County Forestry Department and must follow BMP guidelines. Contractor is responsible for installing broad based dips, water bars and/or using other soil stabilizing techniques where appropriate.

4) Contractor is responsible for obtaining permission to cross private property. Ingress and egress to this sale is the responsibility of the contractor.

5) Permission must be granted by the Forestry Department to use the snowmobile trail from December 1 to March 31. Ample snow cover must be maintained to allow safe snowmobile operation.

6) Special care must be taken to not damage or disturb survey markers.

7) In order to protect advanced regeneration whole tree skidding with tops attached will be subject to field approval.

8) Portions of this sale are wet and will require frozen ground/snow covered logging conditions.

9) In order to maximize vegetative sprouting the red maple clearcut area must be harvested during leaf off conditions.
