Inactivated quadrivalent flu vaccine (shot) and live attenuated vaccine (flu mist) available as supplies last. No thimerosal or latex.

How Much?

No cost to families, no insurance needed. If your child has Medicaid or Badger-care, please have the Child's 10 digit ID number available.

How?

Drive thru with parents or guardians present in vehicle.
