## CONSTRUCTION NOTES

- 1. A pre-construction meeting shall be scheduled with County personnel, the contractor, and the landowner prior to construction start-up.
- 2. The contractor and/or landowner shall notify the County at least 3 days prior to start-up of construction.
- 3. Before the well is filled and sealed, the pump and its associated piping, any ungrouted liner pipe, or other obstacles must be removed from the well. If debris has been thrown in the well, a well driller may have to first drill it out. After the well is cleared, it must be filled from the bottom up with neat cement grout, sand-cement grout, concrete or approved bentonite chips.

NOTE: This plan highlights bentonite chips to be used as the fill material. If other material is to be used, notify Lincoln County Land Services Department at 715-539-1054 for confirmation.

- 4. Except when using bentonite chips, a well driller or pump installer may not just pour or dump the filling material into the well without the use of a conductor pipe because this could cause the filling material to become diluted or bridge in the well part-way down. If dilution occurs, the fill material will not be impermeable. If bridging occurs, the well will only get partially filled.
- 5. After properly filling and sealing the well, the filling material may terminate a minimum of 3 feet below the existing ground surface. The remaining casing can be cut to this level.
- 6. Use clean fill to gently slope the area over the filled well. Ensure that ponding will not occur over the closed well. Runoff should be directed away from the closed well.
- 7. Establish and maintain a grass cover over the abandonment site.
- 8. Well filling and sealing reports must be used to report how the well was filled and sealed and document that the well no longer exists. The licensed person performing the well filling and sealing work MUST complete and submit the form ONLINE.


