

NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR NONMETALLIC MINING

The Lincoln County Land Services Committee* will hold an Informational Public Hearing on Thursday, June 11, 2020 at 3:00p.m.to take testimony on the items listed below. The informational public hearing will be held at the Lincoln County Service Center, Meeting room #255/257/260, at 801 N. Sales St., Merrill, WI. NON-METALLIC MINING APPLICATION

The Lincoln County Land Services office has received an application for a nonmetallic mining reclamation permit on property owned by Gary and Lynne Dalka. James Peterson Sons, Inc. will operate the mine. The property is located in Section 3, T35N-R8E, in the Town of Harrison having a tax parcel numbers of 01-035080-319-997. The application proposes to extract rock and gravel on approximately 12.3 acres of previously agricultural land. The reclamation plan proposes a post mine use of agricultural. All non-farmed areas will be planted to native vegetation with final slopes no greater than 4 to 1.

Pursuant to section 12.04 (15) of Lincoln County Ordinances original applications and materials may be viewed at the **Lincoln County Land Services office located at 801 N. Sales Street, Merrill, Wisconsin**. An information public hearing has been requested. The Lincoln County Land Services office will hold an informational public hearing on June 11 at 3:00pm in Service Center Room #255/257/260. The hearing shall be conducted as an informational hearing for the purpose of explaining and receiving comment from affected persons on the nature, feasibility and effects of the proposed reclamation. The subject matter and testimony at this informational hearing shall be limited to reclamation of the nonmetallic mine site.
