Why Tourism is a Great Investment

- 2022 Economic Impact of Tourism
 - Combined totals for NC ITBEC Counties
 - Record breaking \$1.5 billion in total economic impact through tourism activity
 - 10% increase over 2021
 - 6% increase over 2019 which was the previous record setting year
 - 10,572 full and part-time employees
 - Statewide, 1 in 21 jobs are sustained through tourism
 - \$90.5 million in state and local tax revenue
 - Statewide, \$620 per household
