AMC Updates	Group	 Large discussion on how to navigate AMC through court and the frustration with how long it is taking. Oneida & Langlade Counties do not do JIPS – what is their solution? Taylor County has the same process as Lincoln – they will send an example of the conditions that they use. If the school does not pursue AMC/Truancy referrals, the districts report card, graduation rates and truancy rates drastically drop. Larger counties are contracted with other agencies to work with truant kids but Lincoln County does not have these services available. The lack of resources in Lincoln County is the reason why we cannot implement these plans. Conversation with group on specific cases that have been brought to court. Can Fehrenbach send an email to the school about the conversations discussed with the family? This may help to know what was tried and what failed with families. Release of Information will need to be signed between the school and Public Defender's Office.
