5. State Report: Welcome Visitors: Jill Wolff Swede Rd. Ms. Wolff presented safety concerns as she lives at the corner of Swede Rd // State Rd 107. There was a Crash on August 28th leaving one dead; Ms. Wolff’s concern is for the safety of drivers as well as her family and property. She has been in contact with the DOT in regards to the number of crashes at this location. Some suggested solutions to this issue may be; to reduce the speed at that corner, Resurface the road or to place a barrier in this area. Ms. Wolff will attempt to get a letter from the township making a formal requests.

 - There are new indicator numbers that specify exactly how many fatalities and exactly how many injuries have occurred.
 - Flags: a new flag that indicates if a driver is 65+ in age(this flag doesn’t indicate fault, just age) Also a flag that indicated damage to Government Property
 - Pinpointing Crash’s was discussed as far as trying to be as accurate with the pins put on the map for location
 - TSC Resource: will now be on community mapping.
