- A Trail for Home featuring Gravel Pit Hill
- B Bridge Lake
- C Hill That Won't End(X to C), Raspberry Field, Saddle
- D Dog Lake
- E Squeeze Trees, for tree huggers
- F Rails
- G Round Top, probably our most popular, now with 100% more
- H That One Trail
- I Billy Goat Hill, Stumpjumper, White Lightning
- J Homestead, The homestead of Bill Underdown is 100 yards in front of you as you take the log drop at the top
- K Fun way to finish
- L Ice Age Trail from Copper Lake Road
- M Hollow to Heartbreak Ridge and Loop Road, includes some Ice Age Trail
- N Ice Age Trail with lots of tough hills and the Dog Lake campsite
- O Ice Age Trail, Mist Lake
- S Alternate Oktoberfest loop
- T Oktoberfest: Underdown Lake, trail from Horn Lake Road over the biggest climb in the system
- TT Underdown Lake
- U Tight and Technical
- V In case trail U didn't thump you enough
- X 3 hour cut-off, X to C Hill to Loop Road to the Hollow, Tight, technical and hilly
- Y Yin Yang Hill, 360 up, 360 down
- Z A roller-coaster start right out of the parking lot

Trails A-K comprise the Thunderdown race course. Single track not in the race course is usually more difficult.

Multi-use double track trails are less technical but still hilly. Ride under control and yield to other users.

Loop Road is not technical but still hilly. Horn Lake Road is neither technical nor hilly.
